## Fiber Optic Cable Options

It can transmit data over distances up to 2 km and supports auto-negotiation for duplex and speed, ensuring compatibility with standard 10/100 Mbps routers .

To fully utilize a 100 Mbps fiber connection, a router capable of handling 100 Mbps or higher is recommended. Many modern routers, including dual-band WiFi 5 or WiFi 6 models, can easily handle 100 Mbps speeds. For example, routers like the NETGEAR Nighthawk C7000 provide dual-band wireless connectivity, multiple Ethernet ports, and security features, ensuring stable performance for streaming, gaming, and multiple devices . When choosing a router, ensure it has gigabit Ethernet ports to avoid bottlenecks.

- o Connect the media converter to the router's Ethernet port using a standard RJ45 cable.
- o Configure the router according to your ISP's settings.
- o Test the connection to ensure full 100 Mbps throughput.
