Mapping and Planning

For planning and technical purposes, Albania's electricity network has been digitized in schematic maps, which provide rough locations of transmission lines and substations. While these maps are not suitable for high-precision engineering, they offer a useful overview for infrastructure planning and distribution box placement. Open-source platforms like Open Infrastructure Map also provide visualizations of Albania's electricity and telecom infrastructure.
