- 4. Heat Dissipation and Safety** Solid-bottom trays trap heat and are generally avoided in pump rooms with high-current cables. Ladder or ventilated trays allow heat to dissipate, reducing the risk of insulation melting and electrical failures.
- 5. Future Expansion and Load Capacity** Pump room cable trays are designed to accommodate current cable loads plus additional capacity (typically 25%) for future expansion. NEMA load classes (e.g., 12C or 20B) guide the selection of trays capable of supporting heavy cables over long spans.
- 6. Protection Against Environmental Factors** Materials such as stainless steel, aluminum, or galvanized steel are used to resist corrosion, moisture, and chemical exposure in pump rooms, ensuring long-term durability and compliance with industrial standards.
