White fiber optic cables are optical cables with a white outer jacket, used primarily for short-distance data transmission and easy identification in networking and telecommunications applications.

Overview

White fiber optic cables are standard fiber optic cables distinguished by their white outer jacket, which is achieved by adding pigments during the manufacturing of the protective sheath. The cable itself contains thin glass or plastic fibers that transmit light signals for high-speed data communication, enclosed in a protective jacket made from materials such as PVC, LSZH (Low Smoke Zero Halogen), or Plenum-rated compounds depending on the installation environment (indoor, plenum, or riser) .

Applications

These cables are commonly used in:

- o Telecommunications and networking: Connecting computer networks, telephone systems, and Internet service providers .
 - o Cable television: Delivering high-speed video signals.
 - o Medical imaging: Transmitting data in imaging equipment.
 - o Military communications: Secure and reliable data transmission.
 - o Short-distance data transmission: Ideal for indoor or campus networks where color coding is less critical .
- The white color is primarily for visual identification and does not affect the optical performance of the fiber. It is often chosen for aesthetic reasons or to distinguish specific cables in complex installations .

Types and Specifications

White fiber optic cables can be either single-mode (OS1/OS2) or multimode (OM3/OM4), depending on the core size and intended transmission distance. Single-mode fibers are typically used for long-distance, high-speed applications, while multimode fibers are optimized for shorter distances and high-bandwidth data centers . Cables may come in tight-buffered or loose-tube constructions, with additional strength members like Kevlar or aramid yarn for durability and protection against tension or environmental stress .
