Material Preparation and Inspection

All cable trays, ladders, and accessories must be inspected upon delivery to ensure compliance with approved material submittals. Materials should be stored horizontally on flat surfaces with timber supports at intervals of about one meter, protected from moisture and direct sunlight. Support and Hanging System

Install supports using threaded rods with metal plugs, fixing 'L' angles or slotted 'C' channels with nuts. Maintain a maximum spacing of 1.2 meters between supports to prevent sagging. Provide additional support for bends, branches, and offsets. Ensure all trays are bonded to the main earthing system using copper wire for continuity .

Installation Procedure

- o Position and secure trays according to marked routes.
- o Install bends, tees, and reducers as per the layout.
- o Fix covers if required, ensuring proper alignment.
- o Check for level and alignment using appropriate tools like levels and measuring tapes.
- o Verify clearances from other services and structural elements.

Compliance and Safety

Follow local Brunei electrical codes and international standards such as NEMA VE1/VE2 for cable tray systems. Ensure trays are not subjected to voltages, currents, or temperatures beyond their rated specifications.
