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Cable Separation: Separate weak current cables (data, instrumentation) from heavy current cables (power) to prevent interference. Typically, weak current cables are placed inside the tray, while heavy current cables are routed outside or in separate trays .

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Spacing and Bundling: Maintain proper spacing between cables to avoid overheating. Use rungs or dividers to support cables and prevent sagging. A rung spacing of 150-230 mm (6-9 inches) is recommended for most applications .

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Bend Radius: Respect the minimum bend radius of cables when entering or exiting the tray to prevent damage to insulation and conductors .

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Ventilation and Heat Dissipation: Open or perforated trays allow airflow around cables, reducing heat buildup. Solid trays may be used where aesthetics or protection from dust is required, but ensure heat does not accumulate excessively .

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Material Selection: Choose tray material based on environmental conditions. Aluminum offers corrosion

resistance and light weight, stainless steel provides high corrosion resistance in harsh environments, and galvanized steel is suitable for general industrial use .

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Accessibility and Maintenance: Ensure sufficient clearance above and around the tray for inspection, maintenance, and future cable additions .

Best Practices

- o Use cable ties or clamps to secure cables within the tray without over-tightening.
- o Avoid overloading trays; follow manufacturer load ratings.
- o Plan cable routes to minimize sharp bends and crossings.
- o Label cables for easy identification and troubleshooting.
- o Regularly inspect trays for corrosion, loose fittings, or damaged cables.
