

Cable tray bracket distance 6 meters

In conclusion, the traditional guideline suggests bracket spacing of approximately every 1 to 1. Although BS 7671 touches on the subject of cable supports, it does not detail specifically what these support distances should be. 8 (Other Mechanical Stresses (AJ)) in that document provides requirements for cable support.
