- o Single-core cables are preferred for large fault current systems, and they should be properly cleated rather than zip-tied to withstand electrodynamic forces .
- o Maintain proper grounding and separation of circuits to avoid interference and ensure safety.

- o Verify that the tray width and load class are sufficient for the combined cable weight .
