- o Compatibility: Tee fittings must match the width and type of the straight tray sections to maintain structural integrity and cable support .
- o Corrosion Protection: Selection of coating or finish should consider environmental exposure, such as indoor, outdoor, or chemical environments .
- o Load Capacity: Ensure the tee fitting can support the combined weight of all cables routed through the branch and main runs .
- o Installation Sequence: Typically, the main tray run is installed first, followed by the tee branch, with all supports and accessories installed according to manufacturer guidelines and field conditions .
