Transportation Methods

Road Transport: The most common method, offering flexibility and direct delivery.

 - o Large flatbed or box trucks accommodate heavier or bulkier trays, allowing secure stacking and protection during transit.
 - o Dedicated delivery services provide faster, personalized transport for sensitive or high-value shipments .
- Rail Transport:** Preferred for long-distance or bulk shipments due to cost-effectiveness and capacity to handle large volumes .

Packaging and Securing

- o **Bundling:** Cable trays should be packed in balanced bundles using adequate banding to prevent shifting during transport .
- o **Crates and Cases:** For transshipment or rough handling, wooden crates or cases provide additional protection .
- o **Padding:** Use soft materials like bubble wrap or foam sheets to reduce friction and prevent scratches or deformation .
- o **Lifting Considerations:** Forklift tines should pass beneath the bundle, never through the ends unless special packaging or extended tines are used. For crane offloading, use lifting beams long enough to avoid pressure on tray edges .

Handling and Storage

- o **Loading and Unloading:** Handle trays gently to maintain structural integrity. Avoid inserting lifting equipment into the ends of bundles unless designed for it .
- o **Outdoor Storage:** Hot-dip galvanized, stainless steel, or non-metallic trays can be stored outside if necessary, but stacking should allow drainage and ventilation. Pre-galvanized trays should be stored in dry, ventilated areas to prevent wet storage stains .
- o **Separation by Finish:** Keep products with different finishes apart to avoid contamination or surface damage .

Best Practices

- o Ensure all personnel are trained in safe handling and lifting techniques.
- o Verify that mechanical handling equipment is available on-site for offloading.
- o Protect trays from sharp edges and wear protective gloves during handling .
- o Follow relevant standards such as BS EN 61537 for cable tray systems and BS 6946 for channel support systems . By combining appropriate transport methods, secure packaging, careful handling, and proper storage, cable trays can be delivered safely and efficiently, minimizing damage and ensuring readiness for installation.
