

Can an optocoupler be short-circuited

The output of the opto-coupler is NOT short-circuit proof, in that if the relay coil is shorted or draws too much current the opto transistor will blow. The series resistor determines the LED current. On the input side an infrared light emitting diode is used with all optocoupler types. Commercially.
