General Practice: Cables within the tray should be laid straight and orderly, avoiding crosses or overlaps, and should not protrude. All bends must be securely fastened. The spacing between trays, whether horizontal or vertical, depends on various factors like cable type, environment, and tray material. Proper installation can significantly reduce electromagnetic interference, prevent fire hazards, and improve overall efficiency. A rung spacing of 6 to 9 inches (150 to 230 mm) is preferable when.
