Design and Dimensions

Channel trays typically come in lengths of 1000mm to 3000mm, widths from 100mm to 800mm, and heights of 50mm, 75mm, or 150mm . They may feature solid or ventilated bottoms, with ventilated versions providing airflow for heat dissipation while still maintaining protection . Some systems, like Eaton's KwikSplice, include dovetail splice designs and pre-assembled fittings for quick installation and field modification .
