Power and Connection Issues

A KVM switch may not work if it is not receiving proper power. Check that the power cable is connected, the switch is turned on, and the power adapter is functional. Even if the switch powers on, loose or faulty cables can prevent the display or peripherals from working correctly. Rebooting the switch or testing with high-quality cables can often resolve these issues .

Display and Resolution Problems

If the monitor shows "no signal" or flickers, the problem may be due to resolution incompatibility or incorrect input selection. Lowering the output resolution (e.g., to 720p or 1080p) and ensuring the correct channel is selected can help. Dual-monitor setups require separate video connections for each display, and mismatched adapters or ports can prevent proper signal transmission .

USB and Peripheral Compatibility

Some KVM switches use USB 1.1 ports for hotkey switching, which may not support modern keyboards or wireless dongles. Wireless devices can also experience interference from USB 3.0 devices, causing disconnections. Using separate USB hubs or connecting keyboards and mice to dedicated ports can improve stability .

Complex Desk Setups and Interference

In multi-device or wireless-heavy setups, KVM switches can fail due to signal interference, power fluctuations, or limited scalability. Multiple peripherals competing for bandwidth can cause lag, disconnections, or device malfunctions. Keeping cables short, minimizing interference sources, and ensuring adequate power supply can mitigate these problems .

- o Power cycle the KVM and connected devices, leaving capacitors fully discharged before reconnecting .
- o Test each monitor and PC directly to isolate cable or device issues .
- o Use compatible adapters and ensure video input matches the computer output .
- o Separate wireless dongles from USB 3.0 devices to reduce interference .
