

Connecting a mobile fiber optic cable to a regular router

You cannot connect a fiber optic cable directly to a standard router; you need an Optical Network Terminal (ONT) or media converter to convert the optical signal into an Ethernet signal your router can use.

Required Equipment

- o Optical Network Terminal (ONT): Converts the incoming fiber optic light signal into an electrical Ethernet signal compatible with your router . This is usually provided by your ISP.
- o Fiber Optic Cable: Typically single-mode with SC/APC or SC/UPC connectors .
- o Ethernet Cable: Cat6a or higher is recommended to maintain high-speed performance between the ONT and your router .
- o Router: Standard router with a WAN or Internet port. Ensure it supports gigabit speeds to fully leverage fiber performance .

Step-by-Step Connection

- o Install the ONT: Place the ONT near the fiber entry point in your home. Connect the fiber optic cable from the wall outlet to the ONT's optical input port, handling the cable carefully to avoid bending or damage .
- o Power On the ONT: Plug in the ONT and wait for the status lights to stabilize, indicating a successful connection to your ISP's network .
- o Connect ONT to Router: Use an Ethernet cable to link the ONT's LAN/Ethernet output port to your router's WAN/Internet port .
- o Power On the Router: Turn on your router and wait for the indicator lights to confirm a successful connection. Access the router's configuration interface if needed to adjust settings like Quality of Service (QoS) for optimal performance .
- o Verify Connection: Test your internet connection on a device to ensure the fiber signal is properly converted and transmitted through the router .

Important Precautions

- o Always turn off your router before connecting cables to prevent damage .
- o Avoid bending the fiber optic cable sharply; it is sensitive and can degrade signal quality .
- o Keep connectors clean and free from dust; use protective caps when not connected .
- o Ensure both ONT and router are placed in a dry, ventilated area with stable power supply . By following these steps, your mobile fiber optic connection will be properly converted and routed through a standard router, allowing you to enjoy high-speed, low-latency internet safely and reliably .
