Construction and Types

Copper braids are made from high-purity electrolytic copper wire (minimum 99.9%), which can be bare, tinned, or silver-plated depending on environmental and electrical requirements . They are available in flat or tubular configurations, with multiple layers of braided wires to enhance flexibility and coverage. The number of carriers, wires per carrier, and picks per inch (PPI) determine the braid's flexibility, coverage, and current-carrying capacity . Insulation can be added if required for additional protection .

- o Flexibility: Braided copper can bend at any angle, making installation in cable trays and around flanges convenient .
- o High Conductivity: Copper ensures minimal resistance, providing effective grounding and static discharge paths .
- o Durability: Resistant to mechanical stress, vibration, and thermal expansion, maintaining reliable electrical connections .
- o EMI Shielding: Braided copper can reduce electromagnetic interference in sensitive electrical systems .

Installation Considerations

When installing copper braided wires in cable trays:

- o Ensure secure connections at both ends using appropriate lugs or clamps.
- o Maintain sufficient braid length to accommodate thermal expansion and mechanical movement.
- o Select the correct braid size and thickness based on current-carrying requirements and environmental conditions.
