Estimated Costs

- o Negotiate bulk purchases of brackets and connectors with suppliers.
- o Plan layout carefully to minimize bends and vertical runs, which require more auxiliary materials. By considering these factors, project planners can accurately budget for both the trays and the necessary auxiliary materials, ensuring a safe and cost-effective installation.
