A distribution box (also called a distribution board, panelboard, or DB box) is the central hub of a building's electrical system, receiving incoming power and distributing it safely to multiple circuits while providing protection through circuit breakers or fuses . Because of its critical role in electrical safety, control, and organization, the electrical or facilities maintenance department is generally responsible for its installation, operation, and maintenance.

Responsibilities

- o Safety and Protection: Monitoring and maintaining circuit breakers, fuses, and residual current devices (RCDs) to prevent overloads, short circuits, and electrical hazards .
- o Maintenance and Troubleshooting: Performing routine inspections, testing, and repairs to ensure reliable power distribution and compliance with safety standards .
- o Documentation and Control: Keeping records of circuits, load distribution, and any modifications to the system, which helps in managing energy use and responding to faults efficiently .

Organizational Context

In larger organizations, the facilities management or electrical engineering department may coordinate with other departments, such as operations or IT, to ensure uninterrupted power supply to critical areas. In residential or commercial buildings, a licensed electrician or building maintenance team often assumes responsibility for the distribution box.
