

Dimensions of fire doors for electrical distribution boxes

The table below gives common fire door dimensions used for specification and early project planning. Final approval should always be based on the local code, fire rating certificate, frame details, wall opening, and hardware schedule. 900 x 2100 mm is one of the most common. Electrical enclosure sizes are not universal, but most manufacturers follow common size families. In planning and designing their installations, expert electrical planners and engineers or switchgear manufacturers are responsible for.
