

Dimensions of low-voltage distribution boxes in Portugal

Indoor LV Distribution Boxes (GGD Type)

For outdoor applications, ADU-type LV distribution boards are used in public areas and for grid connections:

- o Mounting: Floor-mounted on a base
- o Enclosure Types: PNT, DIN, and concrete
- o Protection Level: Typically IP55 for weather resistance
- o Features: Incoming/outgoing connections to the grid and end customers, metallic grounding sheet, and secure locking systems
- o Construction: Reinforced 2 mm GI sheet steel, slanted roof with overhang, concealed hinges, and solid earthing points

 - o Expansion for future power requirements
- Outdoor boxes often include slanted roofs, reinforced panels, and IP55 protection, whereas indoor GGD panels prioritize compact modularity and IP30 protection .
