

Disadvantages of laying fiber optic cable reels flat

Reels should be stored upright on flat surfaces or on dedicated rack systems designed for cable drums. Prolonged UV exposure degrades polyethylene and PVC jacket materials, causing brittleness and cracking. (Figure 2) The fiber cable reel with compromised structure will eventually loosen the wraps and may not provide for a smooth even. To assure undamaged cables, it is always good practice to handle fiber optic cables with care. Fiber Optic cable is sensitive to excessive pulling, bending and crushing forces. Field technicians should never leave cable reels on open truck beds or staging areas without. Such damage can degrade cable performance to the extent that replacement becomes necessary.

During transportation, the cable drum should not be kept in a flat or horizontal position, as it may get loose or crush the down layers of the cable resulting into cable/fiber breakage.
