Distance Requirements: Maintain a minimum clearance of 1.0 meter from all accessible faces of a switchboard. Switch box shall be distributed by the final sub-distribution box. The power distribution box and switch box must be rainproof and dustproof. Generally, distribution boxes can be divided into three levels of secondary protection, that is, three levels of distribution boxes: general. Working space: The front clearance, side clearance, and height clearance requirements for electrical equipment that provide a safe area for maintenance, inspections, and other work. Dedicated space: The space equal to the width and depth of electrical equipment in addition to the space extending. The IEC (International Electrotechnical Commission) and BS 7671 (British Standard for Electrical Installations) both provide essential requirements for electrical installations, including those for fuse boards like garage unit, consumer unit and distribution board. While the IEC 60364 standard. Governed by NEC 110.26, these rules define the minimum Spaces about electrical equipment necessary for workers to perform tasks like inspection, maintenance, and replacement safely.
