

Article Overview

Distribution boxes/cabinets are typically fabricated from robust materials, provide IP-rated protection, and include standardized busbar and switchgear arrangements to ensure safe and reliable electrical distribution.

Material and Construction

Distribution boxes are generally made from 2 mm galvanized steel (GI) or powder-coated steel for durability and corrosion resistance, with reinforced panels and channels for structural integrity . Outdoor cabinets often feature slanted roofs with overhangs to prevent water ingress and Godrej-type 3-position locking systems for security . Doors may have concealed hinges and solid earthing points on either side, and the boxes are designed to accommodate cable glands and gland plates for incoming and outgoing cables .

Protection and Safety

- o Ingress Protection (IP): Outdoor cabinets typically conform to IP-55, ensuring protection against dust and water jets .
- o Switchgear Safety: Switch disconnectors and MCCBs are equipped with padlocking in OFF position, inbuilt phase barriers, and IP-20 front protection covers to prevent accidental contact with live parts .
- o Arc Protection: Arc chutes and double-break contacts are used to extinguish arcs and ensure complete isolation during faults .

Busbar and Electrical Arrangement

- o Busbars: Copper or EC-grade aluminum busbars are used, with sizes depending on the box rating (e.g., 25x4 mm copper for LTDBs, 72x50x8 mm aluminum for 63/100 KVA, 1120x50x15 mm for 160/315 KVA), .
- o Incoming/Outgoing Devices: Boxes can accommodate switch disconnectors, MCCBs, RCDs, and CT-operated meters. Outgoing circuits are protected with triple-pole MCCBs and interconnected via busbars or links .
- o Cable Entry: Ample knock-outs on top, bottom, and rear allow flexible cable and conduit entry, with heavy-duty double compression cable glands .

Standards and Testing

- o Compliance with DIN EN 61439, DIN 43629, IS 13947, IS 13411, and other relevant standards is required .
- o Type Testing: Cabinets and switchgear must have type test certificates from approved laboratories (e.g., CPRI or NABL-accredited labs) for protection degree, electrical performance, and mechanical integrity .
- o Identification: Non-detachable nameplates and punch marks for purchaser identification are standard .

- o Modular designs allow easy mounting and replacement of MCBs, adjustable nuts and studs for panel assembly, and removable gland plates .
