

Distribution box dimensions length width height

Distribution boxes vary in size depending on type, series, and number of circuits, with typical dimensions ranging from 100-415 mm in length, 105-323 mm in width, and 75-140 mm in height.

Standard Dimensions by Series

- o MB-ABC Series: Length 200-328 mm, Width 172-174 mm, Height 95 mm, suitable for modular AC circuits 220V/380V in residential and commercial buildings .
- o HA, HK, LGD Series: Length 100-415 mm, Width 105-323 mm, Height 75-140 mm, made of flame-resistant ABS plastic .
- o TOP Series (TOP-TS, TOP-TF, TOP-LS, TOP-PS, TOP-PF, TOP-S): Dimensions vary according to the number of ways (1-36 ways), with length, width, and height specified per model .
- o Single-phase and multi-element boxes: Outer frame sizes range from 610x550x170 mm to 860x840x170 mm, with embedded wall sizes slightly smaller to accommodate installation .

Material and Construction

Most distribution boxes are made from ABS or polycarbonate, providing flame resistance, impact resistance, and insulation properties. Wall-mounted or embedded designs are common, with thicknesses typically between 4-6 mm .

Determining the Size

The size of a distribution box depends on:

- o Number of switches or circuit breakers: Each switch typically requires 18 mm of width; additional space is added for wiring and safety clearances .
- o Incoming line size: Larger cables require more depth to accommodate bending radius and terminal connections .
- o Installation type: Embedded boxes require slightly smaller dimensions than surface-mounted boxes to fit within walls .

Measurement Guidelines

- o Length (L): Longest side of the box base.
- o Width (W): Shorter side of the box base, perpendicular to length.
- o Height (H): Vertical distance from the base to the top of the box .
- o Proper sizing ensures safe installation, prevents overcrowding, and allows for future expansion. By
