

Distribution boxes are exempt from inspection in Tanzania

Article Overview

Distribution boxes may qualify for exemption from pre-shipment inspection in Tanzania if they meet the criteria for exempted goods under the PVoC program, but an official exemption letter from TBS is required.

PVoC Program Overview

The Pre-shipment Verification of Conformity (PVoC) program in Tanzania ensures that imported goods comply with national and international standards before entering the market. Products regulated under PVoC typically require a Certificate of Conformity (CoC) issued by authorized bodies such as TUV Rheinland or SGS, which is mandatory for customs clearance . Without a CoC, shipments may be rejected, fined, or subjected to destination inspection upon arrival .

Exemption Criteria

Certain goods can be exempted from PVoC inspection if they meet specific criteria, including:

- o Capital goods used for production or business operations, not for resale or immediate consumption .
- o Goods imported for government projects, mining, or exploration activities, provided relevant licenses and exemption applications are submitted .
- o Items listed in the TBS exempted products list, which may include electrical equipment or machinery components, depending on the classification . Exemptions are granted per shipment or annually, and an official exemption letter from TBS is required to clear customs without pre-shipment inspection . If no exemption letter is provided, the goods must undergo standard PVoC inspection and obtain a CoC.

Distribution Boxes

While the sources do not explicitly list "distribution boxes," these are typically considered electrical equipment or capital goods. If they are imported as part of a business project, industrial installation, or government project, they may qualify for exemption. Importers must:

- o Apply to TBS for an exemption letter, providing details of the shipment, intended use, and supporting licenses or project documentation.
- o Ensure compliance with Tanzanian standards (or acceptable international equivalents like IEC or ISO) even if exempted from pre-shipment inspection .
- o Use the exemption letter at customs to avoid mandatory CoC inspection .

Destination Inspection

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Goods exempted from pre-shipment inspection are still subject to destination inspection upon arrival in Tanzania. This ensures that the shipment matches the declared specifications and complies with safety and quality standards .
