Using Your Existing Router

You can often use your existing router if it has a Gigabit Ethernet WAN port and supports the speeds offered by your fiber plan. Routers designed for DSL or cable with phone line or coaxial inputs will not work directly with fiber. Older routers with Wi-Fi 4 or Wi-Fi 5 may limit your internet speeds, especially if your fiber plan exceeds 500 Mbps.

When to Upgrade Your Router

Upgrading is recommended if your current router:

- o Lacks a Gigabit WAN port
 - o Cannot handle your fiber plan's maximum speeds
 - o Uses older Wi-Fi standards (Wi-Fi 6 or 6E is preferred for speed and efficiency)
 - o Has limited processing power for multiple devices or high-bandwidth applications
- A fiber-compatible router ensures low latency, better device management, and the ability to fully utilize symmetrical upload and download speeds.

Additional Considerations

- o Some ISPs provide a router optimized for their fiber network, which is pre-configured for seamless operation.
- o If you use your own router, you are responsible for network security and troubleshooting.
- o For VoIP phone services over fiber, older analog phones may need replacement with VoIP-compatible devices.
