- o Connect the Ground Wire: Use a copper core wire with yellow-green insulation, ensuring the cross-sectional area meets local code requirements. Strip the wire, attach it securely to the PE bar, and tighten the terminal screw to prevent loosening .
- o Ground Electrical Components: Any metallic components inside the box that require grounding should also be connected to the PE bar to maintain safety .
- o Verify Resistance: The total ground resistance should be low (typically
