Overview

A drop cable with a pigtail is a fiber optic cable that connects the main distribution network to the end-user premises. The pigtail is a short fiber segment with a factory-terminated connector (e.g., SC/APC, LC, FC) that allows for fusion splicing or direct connection to optical network terminals (ONTs) or patch panels. These cables are widely used in FTTH, FTTB, telecom, broadband, and CATV networks .

- o **Flat Drop Cable:** Compact, easy to strip, and ideal for tight spaces; often used in last-mile outdoor installations .
- o **Round Drop Cable:** Offers additional mechanical protection; suitable for aerial or duct installations .
- o **Self-Supporting Aerial Cable:** Includes a steel messenger wire (Figure-8 design) for spanning poles without additional support .
- o **Toneable/Dielectric Cables:** Include a conductor for underground detection or non-metallic strength members to prevent lightning interference .

- o **Telecom Networks:** Reliable signal transmission in outdoor and indoor environments .
