

Dual power supply lighting distribution box installed

A dual power supply lighting distribution box ensures continuous lighting by distributing power from two separate sources and can independently control multiple luminaire groups.

Purpose and Function

These boxes can also control two groups of luminaires independently, supporting standard on/off or dimmable lighting, and can be expanded with additional outlets or tap-off boxes ().

- o Assess Power Requirements: Calculate the total wattage of connected luminaires and ensure the distribution box can handle the load ().
- o Wiring: Connect both power supplies to the box, ensuring proper phase alignment and adherence to local electrical codes. Input terminals typically accept multiple conductor sizes (e.g., 3 x 2.5mm², 2 x 4mm², or 1 x 6mm²) ().
- o Mounting: Use the supplied snap-on/off single-point fixing brackets for secure installation. Ensure the box is mounted in a location that allows easy access for maintenance ().
- o Safety Compliance: Follow all relevant standards, including the National Electrical Code (NFPA 70), IEEE guidelines, and local regulations. Use personal protective equipment during installation ().
- o Testing: Verify that the automatic transfer function works correctly by simulating a power failure. Ensure all connected luminaires operate as expected from both power sources ().

- o Regularly inspect wiring integrity and load distribution.
- o Ensure expansion or tap-off connections are secure.
- o Test the automatic transfer switch periodically to confirm seamless switching between power sources.
