Key Features

- o Voltage Range: Modules typically support 5VDC to 24VDC or 16VAC to 28VAC, making them versatile for low-voltage applications .
- o Status Indicators: LED indicators show which input is active and the output voltage, helping with monitoring and troubleshooting .
- o Mounting and Design: Many modules are DIN rail-mounted, compact, and designed for easy wiring with screw clamp terminals, saving panel space and simplifying installation .
