Electrical box clamps are devices used to secure cables to enclosures or outlet boxes, providing strain relief and ensuring safe, organized wiring.

Purpose and Function

Electrical box clamps are designed to secure building cables, such as Romex (NM-B) or metallic conduit cables, to electrical boxes or enclosures. They prevent cables from being pulled out, reduce strain at connection points, and help maintain compliance with electrical codes. Many clamps also provide a seal against moisture, with rubber bushings or O-rings for protection in wet or high-pressure environments (McMaster-Carr) .

Types of Clamps

- o Screw-down clamps: These clamps tighten around the cable using a screw, offering superior pull-out resistance and strain relief .
- o Snap-in cord grips: Inserted into a knockout in the box, these grips hold the cable securely without additional screws .
- o Metallic conduit clamps: Designed for EMT, MC, or armored cables, often made of zinc or steel for durability .
- o Adjustable or universal clamps: Can accommodate different cable sizes and box types, sometimes with locking tabs for easy conduit placement .

Installation Steps

- o Select the appropriate clamp for the cable type and box size.
- o Insert the clamp into the knockout of the electrical box or enclosure.
- o Position the cable through the clamp, ensuring it fits snugly but is not overly compressed.
- o Tighten the screw or locking mechanism to secure the cable and provide strain relief.
- o Check alignment and seal if the clamp includes a rubber bushing or O-ring for moisture protection .

Applications

- o Residential wiring: Securing NM-B cables to outlet boxes or junction boxes.
- o Commercial installations: Organizing and protecting MC or EMT cables in enclosures.
- o Data centers and industrial setups: Maintaining cable organization and preventing damage from tension or movement .
