Fiberglass-Reinforced Plastic (FRP): FRP trays are non-conductive and highly resistant to chemical exposure, making them ideal for corrosive environments such as chemical plants or marine settings. They are lightweight and corrosion-proof but generally less strong than steel . **PVC or Plastic Trays:** These are cost-effective and corrosion-resistant, suitable for light-duty applications. They are not recommended for heavy cable loads or areas with high mechanical stress .
