- o Designed for generator connections to safely switch between utility and backup power.
- o Include manual or automatic switches and inlet boxes for generator cords .
- o Available in 30A, 50A, or higher amperage ratings, suitable for home or commercial backup systems .

Key Features to Consider

- o **Material:** Metal boxes offer durability and grounding; non-metallic boxes are lightweight and corrosion-resistant .
- o **Gang Size:** Determines how many switches or devices can be installed; larger boxes allow multiple circuits in one enclosure .
- o **Depth and Volume:** Must accommodate wiring volume and device size; deeper boxes are needed for multiple switches or breakers .



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- o Mounting Options: Nail-on, screw-on, or adjustable brackets for wall, ceiling, or surface mounting .
- o Safety Ratings: Look for UL-listed, IP-rated, or GFCI-protected options for compliance and protection .
