

Erecting a cable tray tee

Article Overview

Installing a cable tray tee involves careful planning, proper support, and precise alignment to ensure safe and code-compliant cable routing.

Planning and Preparation

Before installing a tee, plan the route of the cable tray system, marking the main line and the branch line where the tee will be installed. Identify support points for both the main and branch trays, typically spaced 1.5 to 3 meters apart depending on tray type and load . Ensure the area is clear of obstructions like pipes, HVAC ducts, or structural elements .

Selecting the Tee and Tray Type

Choose a tee fitting compatible with your tray type (ladder, ventilated trough, or solid-bottom). Ladder trays are ideal for power cables due to ventilation and easy cable anchoring, while ventilated troughs provide continuous support for smaller control or instrumentation cables . Ensure the tee matches the material and finish of the existing tray to maintain structural integrity and corrosion resistance .

Installation Steps

- o Align the Tee: Position the tee so the branch line extends at the correct angle from the main tray. Use a level or laser to ensure proper alignment .
- o Secure Supports: Install mounting brackets or wall/ceiling supports at the tee junction and along the branch line. Use threaded rods, anchor bolts, or struts as required .
- o Connect the Tee: Attach the tee to the main tray using couplers or splice plates. Ensure all bolts are tightened and the connection is flush to prevent sagging .
- o Check Grounding and Bonding: Bond the tee to the main tray system to maintain electrical continuity and comply with NEC requirements .
- o Cable Management: Route cables through the tee carefully, maintaining minimum bend radii and avoiding overcrowding. Use cable ties or separators if necessary to prevent damage .

Safety and Compliance

- o Wear PPE including gloves, safety glasses, and a hard hat .
- o Verify that the installation meets NEC Article 392 and local electrical codes .
- o Inspect all supports, connections, and cable routing before energizing the system .

Final Checks

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After installation, ensure the tee and connected trays are level, secure, and free of sharp edges. Confirm that the cable fill does not exceed recommended limits (usually 50%) and that the system allows for future maintenance or expansion . By following these steps, a cable tray tee can be safely and efficiently integrated into a commercial or industrial cable tray system, ensuring both structural stability and electrical safety.
