Key Components

Suspension Clamps and Tension Clamps These clamps are used to support fiber optic cables between poles, maintaining proper tension and preventing sag. They are critical for ADSS (All-Dielectric Self-Supporting) and FTTH (Fiber to the Home) networks, ensuring the cable remains stable under environmental stress such as wind, ice, or UV exposure . **Brackets and J-Hooks** Brackets attach cables to poles, providing a secure mounting point, while J-hooks guide and support the cable along the pole line. These components help maintain proper cable alignment and prevent abrasion or mechanical damage . **Straps and Buckles** Plastic or metal straps, often used with buckles, secure cables to poles or supporting strands. ABstrap systems, for example, allow adjustable spacing and secure attachment for lashed cable construction . **Grounding Accessories** For OPGW (Optical Ground Wire) or hybrid installations, grounding hardware ensures electrical safety and protects the fiber from lightning or electrical faults . **Preformed Dead-End Grips and Armor Rods** Dead-end grips anchor the cable at intermediate poles, distributing mechanical stress and preventing slippage. Armor rods protect the cable from abrasion at bends or attachment points .

Selection Considerations

- o **Material Quality:** Hardware must resist corrosion, UV exposure, and extreme weather. Poor-quality clamps or brackets can lead to cable sag, abrasion, and service outages .
- o **Environmental Conditions:** Coastal, high-wind, or icy regions require corrosion-resistant and high-strength fittings.
- o **Cable Type:** ADSS, OPGW, and SkyWrap cables have different mechanical requirements, influencing the choice of clamps, grips, and supports .
- o **Longevity:** High-quality hardware is designed to last 20-25 years, reducing maintenance costs and minimizing service interruptions .

Best Practices

- o Ensure proper tensioning of cables to avoid sag and mechanical stress.
- o Use vibration dampers in areas prone to wind-induced oscillation.
- o Regularly inspect hardware for corrosion, wear, or loosening.
- o Match hardware specifications to cable diameter, weight, and environmental load. Intermediate pole hardware is a critical part of the "silent infrastructure" of fiber networks, providing mechanical stability that
