1. Fiber Cable Trays and Lacing Shelves

- o Provide a supportive surface for routing and organizing fiber cables between switches, patch panels, and rackmount equipment.
- o Examples include 1U cable lacing shelves that support up to 10 pounds of fiber and allow horizontal and vertical routing .

2. Fiber Racks and Cabinets

- o Ideal for maintaining neat cable runs and preventing tangling or damage.
- o Multi-purpose racks and cabinets are made from lightweight aluminum or steel with modular accessories for termination and storage.
- o Features include bend limiters, cable trays, vertical ducts, and storage units to maintain clean installations and protect fibers from critical bend diameters .
- o Can be configured side-by-side or back-to-back, with wall-mounted or freestanding options.

3. Rack Mount Distribution Panels

- o Available in 1RU, 2RU, 3RU, and 4RU sizes, these panels support both patching and splicing within the same enclosure.
- o Fully enclose pigtails to reduce cable length, protect fibers, and simplify maintenance.
- o Compatible with multiple adapter types (LC, MPO, SC, FC, ST) and allow modular expansion .

4. Fiber Component Trays

- o Designed for laboratory or optical table setups, these trays hold cylindrical fiber components like couplers, WDMs, circulators, and isolators.
- o Incorporate spring clamps and molded channels to secure fibers and prevent unwanted bending or stress.
- o Trays can be stacked to save space and mounted on optical tables or breadboards .

5. Accessories and Cable Holders

- o Include D-ring cable managers, zip-tie bases, P-clips, self-adhesive clips, and fiber storage reels.
