- o Separate cable types: Keep fiber optic cables distinct from power, Ethernet, and control cables to prevent interference and maintain signal integrity .
- o Avoid overfilling trays: Leave at least 20-30% of tray capacity free for future expansion and to comply with NEC spacing requirements .
- o Secure cables properly: Use cable ties or brackets to fasten cables without compressing them, ensuring long-term stability and safety .

Compliance and Standards

According to the 2023 National Electrical Code (NEC), any listed optical fiber cable is acceptable for tray applications, even though fiber cables do not have a specific tray rating like power cables . Cable trays are designed to support electrical, signal, and communication cables, including fiber, and should not contain water, air, or other mechanical piping .
