10GbE switches commonly use multimode (OM3/OM4) or single-mode (OS1/OS2) fiber with SFP+ modules or active optical cables for high-speed connections.

Types of Fiber Optic Cables

Multimode Fiber (MMF)

- o OM3 and OM4 are the most common multimode fibers for 10GbE.
- o OM3 supports distances up to 300 meters, while OM4 extends this to 400 meters at 10Gbps using 850 nm VCSEL lasers .
- o Ideal for data center or campus connections within buildings.
- o Bend-insensitive variants are available for tight routing with minimal signal loss .
- o Single-Mode Fiber (SMF)
- o OS1 and OS2 fibers are used for long-distance 10GbE links, capable of tens of kilometers depending on transceivers and network design .
- o SMF has a narrower core, reducing modal dispersion and enabling high-speed transmission over long distances.
- o Suitable for inter-building or metropolitan area networks.

SFP+ Modules and Active Optical Cables

SFP+ Transceivers

- o 10GbE switches typically use SFP+ modules to interface with fiber cables.
- o Modules like Cisco 10GBASE-SR support OM3 up to 300m and OM4 up to 400m .
- o Hot-swappable and compatible with multiple 10GbE standards, including 10GBASE-SR, 10GBASE-LR, and 10GBASE-T .
- o Active Optical Cables (AOC)
- o AOCs integrate optical transceivers into a fixed-length fiber cable, providing plug-and-play 10GbE connectivity .
- o Typically used for short to medium distances (up to 100 meters) within racks or adjacent racks.
- o Offer high performance, reduced EMI, and simplified installation compared to separate fiber and transceivers.

Deployment Considerations

- o Distance: Choose MMF for short to medium distances and SMF for long-haul connections.
- o Connector Type: SFP+ modules use LC connectors for fiber; ensure compatibility with switch ports.



Fiber Optic Cables for 10 Gigabit Switches

- o Cost vs. Performance: AOCs are cost-effective for short links, while separate fiber and SFP+ modules provide flexibility for longer distances.
- o Future-Proofing: OM4 or SMF is recommended for networks expecting higher bandwidth or future upgrades. In summary, 10GbE switches can be connected using OM3/OM4 multimode fiber for intra-building links, OS1/OS2 single-mode fiber for long-distance links, or SFP+ active optical cables for short, high-speed connections, with SFP+ modules providing the interface for most fiber deployments .
