A Fiber Access Terminal (FAT), also known as a Fiber Access Terminal Box (ATB) or Fiber Distribution Terminal (FDT), serves as the junction point between distribution fiber cables and drop cables that deliver fiber directly to homes, offices, or multi-dwelling units (MDUs) (). Its primary functions include:

- o Fiber Termination and Splicing: Provides secure points to terminate fiber cables and splice fibers together, ensuring minimal signal loss.
- o Distribution and Port Allocation: Facilitates the connection of multiple subscribers in Passive Optical Network (PON) architectures using PLC splitters to divide one optical signal into several outputs ().
- o Fiber Storage and Management: Offers organized storage for excess fiber, reducing clutter and protecting fibers from tension or damage ().
- o Network Expansion and Maintenance: Allows flexible fiber link distribution, making troubleshooting, network upgrades, and routine maintenance easier ().

Types and Components

- o Indoor or Outdoor Enclosures: Outdoor FATs are typically IP65 or IP68-rated, made from durable PC+ABS plastic or metal, resistant to water, dust, UV rays, temperature fluctuations, and impact ().
- o Internal Components: Include fiber splice trays, adapters, pigtails, fasteners, and storage units to manage fiber connections efficiently ().
- o Integration with PON: Many FATs include compartments for PLC splitters, essential for distributing signals to multiple subscribers in GPON, EPON, or XGS-PON networks ().
