Current Infrastructure

Rwanda has actively expanded its fiber optic network to improve connectivity across the country. Companies like ERTEC Ltd have installed fiber optic transmission lines in districts such as Gicumbi, Nyagatare, and Kayonza, alongside electrification and smart grid projects . These networks support both urban centers and remote areas, enhancing broadband access and digital services.

 - o Color-coded fibers for identification
 - o High splice compatibility and defect-free cable construction
 - o Pre-survey of routes, termination points, and jointing locations before installation
 - o Approval from regulatory authorities for any route changes
- These standards ensure network reliability, interoperability, and long-term performance.

Regional Context

Rwanda, being landlocked, relies on terrestrial fiber optic cables to extend connectivity from submarine cables and regional backbones. Terrestrial networks are critical for economic growth, digital services, and integration
