Fiber optic routers and ONTs typically use standard low-voltage DC power adapters, often supplied with the device, but compatible replacement cords can be purchased separately.

Power Cord Basics

Most fiber optic access routers or Optical Network Terminals (ONTs) require a dedicated power adapter that converts AC mains electricity to low-voltage DC suitable for the device. The specifications--voltage, amperage, and connector type--are usually printed on the router or ONT label. Commonly, these are 5V, 9V, or 12V DC adapters with barrel connectors, but some enterprise devices may use PoE (Power over Ethernet) or specialized powered fiber solutions .

Replacement and Purchase Options

If you need a replacement or extended power cord, you can find versatile router power cables online, including options with longer lengths for flexible placement . Ensure the replacement matches the voltage, current rating, and connector polarity of your original adapter to avoid damage.

Powered Fiber Solutions

Some advanced fiber deployments use powered fiber cabling, which combines fiber-optic data transmission with low-voltage DC power in a single cable. This allows powering remote devices like Wi-Fi access points or IoT devices without separate electrical wiring . These systems are more common in enterprise or campus networks rather than typical home setups.

- o For home setups, standard DC barrel plug adapters are sufficient; for enterprise setups, consider PoE or powered fiber solutions.
- o Avoid using generic adapters with mismatched voltage or polarity, as this can damage the device. By following these guidelines, you can safely power your fiber optic access router and maintain reliable network performance .
