

Fiber optic box can be used as a router

A fiber optic box (ONT) cannot replace a router, but you can connect your own router to it to manage your home network.

Understanding the Fiber Optic Box (ONT)

A fiber optic box, or Optical Network Terminal (ONT), is provided by your ISP to convert the fiber optic signal into an Ethernet connection that your devices can use . The ONT itself does not function as a router; it does not provide Wi-Fi, NAT, or DHCP services. Its primary role is to act as a bridge between the fiber line and your router.

Connecting Your Own Router

You can use almost any modern router with fiber internet, provided it has a Gigabit Ethernet WAN port to handle high-speed connections . Here's how to set it up:

- o Confirm ONT Installation: Ensure your ISP has installed and activated the ONT at your home .
- o Connect the Router: Use an Ethernet cable to connect the ONT's Ethernet port to your router's WAN port .
- o Configure Router Settings: Access your router's admin panel to configure settings such as VLAN, DHCP, or PPPoE if required by your ISP .
- o Power On and Test: Turn on your router and check the connection. Running a speed test can confirm that your router is handling the fiber speeds correctly .

Router Considerations

- o Speed Support: Ensure your router supports the speed tier of your fiber plan. Older routers (Wi-Fi 4 or 5) may limit performance, while Wi-Fi 6 or 6E routers are recommended for optimal speed and device management .
- o Multi-Gig Capability: For plans exceeding 1 Gbps, a router capable of multi-gig speeds is necessary to fully utilize fiber internet .
- o Wi-Fi Coverage: Choose a router with sufficient range and features for your home or office setup.
