Overview of YJV Cables

YJV cables, officially known as Cross-linked Polyethylene Insulated Polyvinyl Chloride Sheathed Power Cables, are widely used in power transmission and distribution systems due to their heat resistance, long service life, and high safety standards. The naming convention follows China GB/T standards:

- o Y: XLPE insulation, providing excellent thermal and electrical stability
 - o J: Copper conductors (Class 1 or 2)
 - o V: PVC outer sheath for mechanical protection and environmental resistance
- These cables are suitable for low-voltage and medium-voltage applications, with rated voltages typically up to 26/35 kV. They can be laid indoors, in tunnels, pipelines, cable trenches, or underground, and are resistant to corrosion and environmental stress, though they cannot withstand high external mechanical forces unless armored.

Fiber Optic Integration

Fiber optic YJV cables combine the power transmission capability of YJV cables with optical fibers for data communication, monitoring, or control purposes. These cables are often used in smart grid systems, industrial automation, and remote monitoring. The optical fibers are typically embedded within the cable structure without compromising the electrical performance, allowing simultaneous power and data transmission.
