Common Indicator Lights and Their Meanings

1. Power (PWR): Indicates whether the device is receiving power. A steady light means the DC power supply is functioning normally, while no light suggests a power issue or faulty adapter ().

2. Fiber Link/Activity (FX Link/ACT or LOS/PON):

- o Steady light: Fiber port is connected to a remote device.

- o Blinking: Data is being transmitted over the fiber.

- o Off or red (LOS): No optical signal detected; check fiber connections, clean connectors, or contact the ISP if the line is broken ().

3. Ethernet Link/Activity (TX Link/ACT or LAN):

- o Steady light: RJ45 connection is stable.

- o Blinking: Data is being transmitted.

- o Off: No connection; check cables and devices ().

4. Speed Indicators (FX 100, 1000M, TX 100):

- o Lights indicate the transmission rate of the fiber or twisted-pair port. For example, FX 100 or TX 100 means 100 Mbps, while 1000M indicates 1 Gbps ().

5. Duplex Mode (FDX/Full Duplex):

- o On: Full-duplex mode active.

- o Off or blinking: Half-duplex or collision detected ().

6. PON (Passive Optical Network) Light: Specific to ONTs, shows whether the device has successfully registered with the ISP's OLT. Blinking during startup is normal; persistent blinking may indicate compatibility or authorization issues ().

Troubleshooting Tips

- o No power: Verify the power adapter and outlet. Try a replacement adapter if necessary ().
- o No fiber link: Ensure the fiber connector is fully seated, clean, and free of sharp bends. If LOS persists, contact the ISP ().
- o No Ethernet link: Test with a different cable or device to rule out port issues ().
- o Blinking lights: Usually indicate active data transmission; irregular blinking may suggest network congestion or faulty cables ().
