

## Article Overview

Electrical boxes in fire-rated walls must be protected with fire-rated materials and clearly labeled to ensure safety, code compliance, and easy identification.

## Fire Protection Requirements

Electrical boxes installed in fire-rated walls or ceilings must maintain the fire-resistance rating of the wall or assembly. This is achieved using firestop products such as putty pads, firestop box inserts, cover plate gaskets, or endothermic mats, which are tested and certified to standards like ASTM E814 and UL 1479 . These materials prevent fire and heat from spreading through the box and protect wiring during a fire. For example, 3M Fire Barrier Electrical Box Inserts expand under heat to seal the box and limit temperature rise, helping maintain 1- or 2-hour rated wall assemblies .

## Labeling Standards

Proper labeling of electrical boxes is critical for safety and compliance. Labels should:

- o Identify the circuit or equipment served by the box.
- o Include fire-rated designation if the box is installed in a fire-rated wall.
- o Warn of potential hazards, such as arc flash or high voltage.
- o Be durable and legible, using materials like vinyl or laminated paper that resist tearing and fading . Industrial and commercial labeling standards are guided by OSHA and other safety regulations, ensuring that workers can quickly identify circuits during maintenance or emergencies . Labels should be placed on the faceplate, inside the panel, or adjacent to the box for clear visibility.

## Recommended Practices

- o Use certified firestop products for all recessed or metallic electrical boxes in fire-rated walls.
- o Apply intumescent inserts or putty pads inside or around the box to maintain fire-resistance ratings.
- o Clearly label each box with circuit information, fire rating, and hazard warnings.
- o Ensure labels are permanent, non-tearable, and resistant to environmental conditions.
- o Follow manufacturer instructions and listing laboratory guidelines for installation and labeling to maintain certification validity . By combining fire-rated protection with proper labeling, electrical boxes in fire-rated assemblies remain safe, code-compliant, and easily identifiable for maintenance or emergency response.
