- o It passes through a main alternating current contactor or main switch, which controls the flow of electricity to downstream circuits .
- o Branch circuits distribute power to localized loads, such as lighting, machinery, or sub-panels, ensuring balanced load distribution and preventing overloads .
- o Protective devices like circuit breakers or fuses safeguard each branch against short circuits or overcurrent conditions .

Fire Protection Features

Fireproof distribution boxes integrate multiple safety mechanisms:

- o Automatic fire suppression: Fire extinguishers connected to nozzles can be activated by temperature or smoke sensors .
- o Circuit integrity (EI-rated): Ensures that the box maintains electrical function during a fire for a specified duration, preventing fire spread to critical circuits .
- o Smoke tightness (Sa/S200): Prevents both hot and cold smoke from entering protected areas .
- o Fire-resistant materials: Enclosures comply with standards such as DIN 4102 (F30/F90) for fire resistance .
