Grounding and Bonding: Proper bonding and grounding of the gas cabinet and associated piping is critical to prevent electrical arcing or damage from lightning strikes. Corrugated stainless steel tubing (CSST) systems should be bonded to the building's grounding electrode system, and dielectric unions may be required at service entry points . 4. Safety Interlocks and Switches: Wiring should integrate excess flow switches, pressure sensors, and purge panel controls to automatically shut off gas flow in case of leaks or overpressure. These devices must be connected according to the manufacturer's instructions to ensure proper operation . 5. Compliance with Codes: All wiring must comply with NFPA standards, UFC, and local electrical and fire codes. This includes separation of incompatible gas types, proper conduit use, and adherence to flammable or toxic gas classifications . 6. Alarm and Monitoring Systems: Gas cabinets often include alarms for oxygen deficiency, toxic gas detection, or high-pressure conditions. Wiring should ensure these alarms are powered and connected to the control panel for immediate notification . 7. Installation Best Practices:

- o Label all electrical and gas lines clearly.
- o Use check valves and traps to prevent backflow.
- o Maintain clear aisles and access for maintenance.
- o Verify all connections with a qualified engineer or technician before energizing the system .
