Purpose and Function

A distribution box (also called a DB box, breaker box, or electrical panel) serves as the central hub for a home's electrical system. It receives electricity from the main supply and divides it into separate circuits for lighting, outlets, and appliances, ensuring safe and organized power distribution throughout the house (). - o The distribution box should be installed close to the main power entry point of the house for easy access ().
- o Ensure proper rating of the box and breakers according to the total load of lighting circuits.
- o IP-rated enclosures (e.g., IP65) are recommended for areas exposed to moisture or dust, such as bathrooms or outdoor lighting circuits ().
- o Regular inspection and maintenance are important to ensure connections remain secure and breakers function correctly ().

Integration with Household Lighting

Each lighting circuit is connected to a dedicated breaker in the distribution box. This allows individual circuits to be isolated for maintenance without affecting the rest of the house. Low-voltage lighting systems, such as LED strips or outdoor garden lights, can also be integrated through specialized subpanels or secondary distribution boxes ().
