

How big is a small electrical distribution box

A typical small electrical distribution box measures around 4" x 4" with depths ranging from 1.5" to 2.125", providing sufficient space for wiring and a single device or a few MCBs.

Standard Sizes

- o Mounting and access: Small boxes often include removable covers or gland plates for easy installation and maintenance .
- o Material and protection: Plastic or metal enclosures are common; IP or NEMA ratings may affect external dimensions slightly .
