Ensure safe placement: install in dry, accessible areas with good ventilation and at appropriate height (typically ~1. Practice good wiring: secure. Put wall-mounted boxes 4. Place outdoor boxes at least 3 feet above the ground. Check and fix the box. The distribution box should be installed in an area close to the power supply to reduce power loss and ensure safety.
